Refund policy for registered students who suspend or withdraw from schooling:

1. Students who apply for suspension or withdrawal on registration day and up to the day before school starts may receive a refund of 2/3 of tuition and full refund of miscellaneous fees and other payment.
2. After school has begun, students who apply for suspension or withdrawal between Week 1 up to Week 6 (included) can receive a refund of 2/3 of tuition, miscellaneous and other fees in total.
3. After school has begun, students who apply for suspension or withdrawal between Week 7 up to Week 12 (included) may receive a refund of 1/3 of tuition, miscellaneous and other fees in total.
4. Students who apply for suspension or withdrawal in Week 13 will not be granted refunds.
