Refund policy for Leaves of Absence (LOA) and Withdrawals:

1. Students who apply for an LOA or Withdrawal on or before the registration deadline (prior to the first day of classes) are eligible for a two-thirds refund of tuition, and a full refund of miscellaneous fees and other related payments.
2. Students who apply for an LOA or Withdrawal from the start of the semester through the end of Week 6 are eligible for a two-thirds refund of the total amount paid, including tuition, miscellaneous, and other fees.
3. Students who apply for an LOA or Withdrawal between Week 7 and Week 12 are eligible for a one-third refund of the total amount paid, including tuition, miscellaneous, and other fees.
4. Students who apply for an LOA or Withdrawal from Week 13 onwards are not eligible for a refund; all fees are non-refundable.
